Book your accommodations

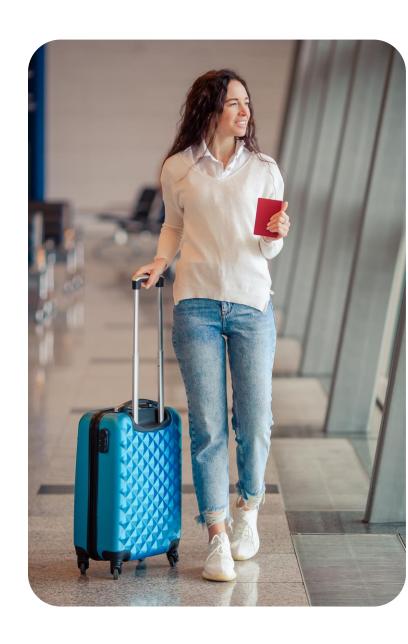
Choose accommodations with breakfast; it's more convenient and oftentimes more cost-efficient.

Purchase extra health insurance coverage
